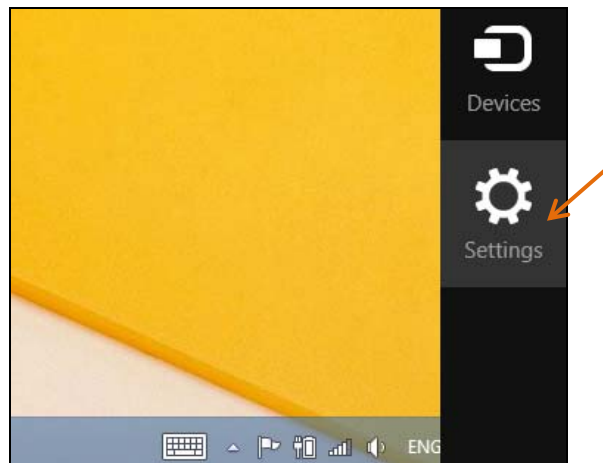

A. Introduction

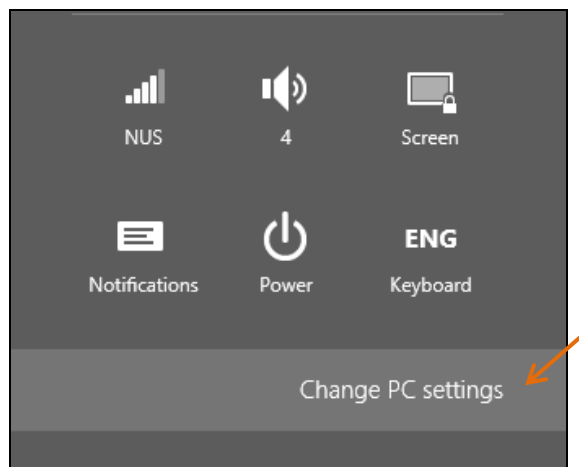
This document shows the step by step instructions on how to use the built-in feature in Windows 8.1 to connect to NUS VPN. This is useful for Surface RT users as you cannot install the NUS WebVPN client.

B. Configure NUS VPN

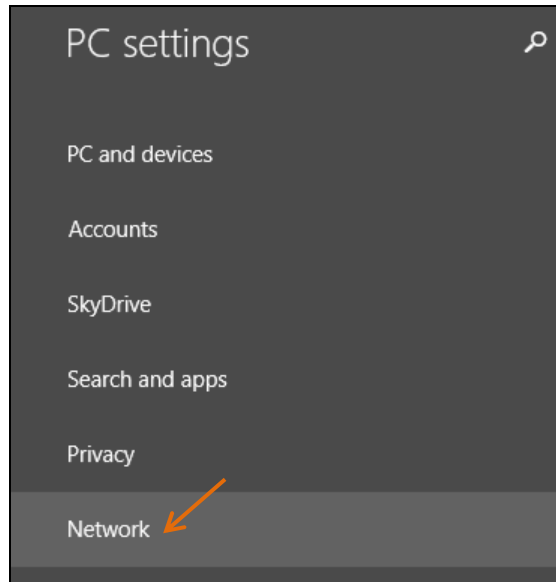
1. Go to the Charms bar and click on **Settings**.



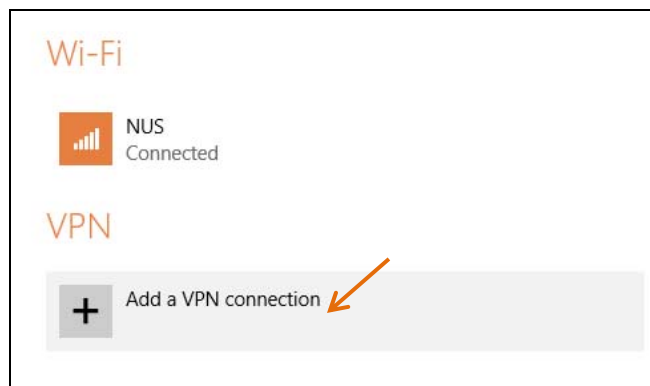
2. Click on **Change PC settings**.



3. Click on **Network**.



4. Click on **Add a VPN connection**.



5. Enter the following in the settings:

a. Select “**Juniper Networks Junos Pulse**” for the VPN provider.

b. Provide a description name for the connection.

c. Enter **webvpn.nus.edu.sg** for the server name.

d. Click **Save**.

Optional: you can tick on “Remember my sign-in info” if you want the connection to remember your login credentials.

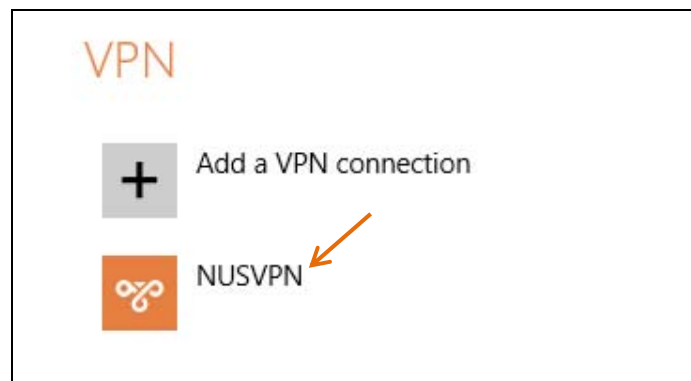

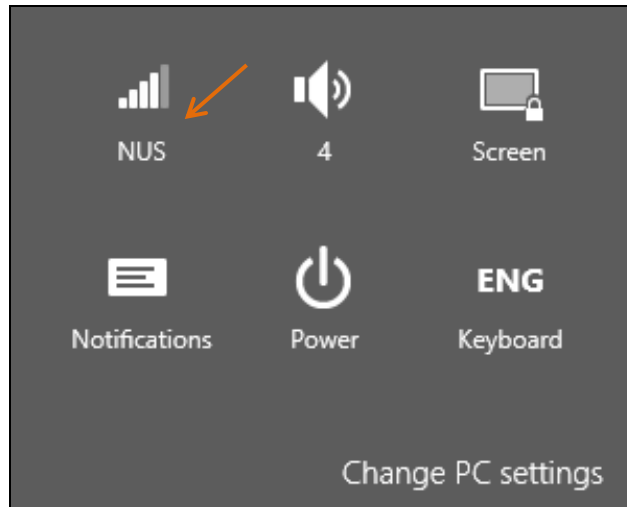

6. The VPN connection is now added.



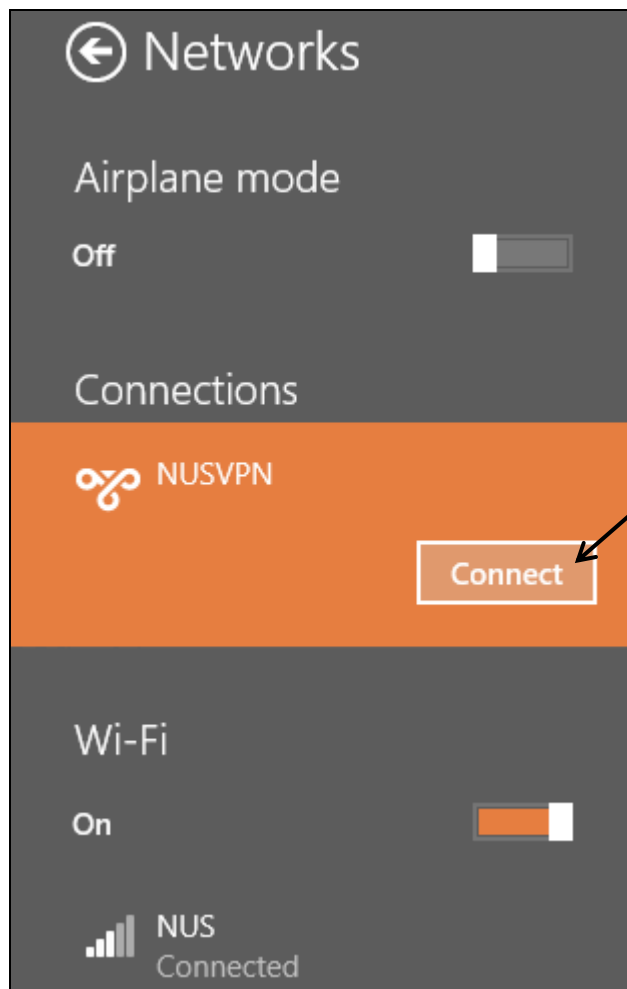
7. Go back to Charms bar and click on **Settings** again.

Click on the network icon.



8. Under **Connections**, you will now see the option to connect to NUS VPN.

Select it and click **Connect**.

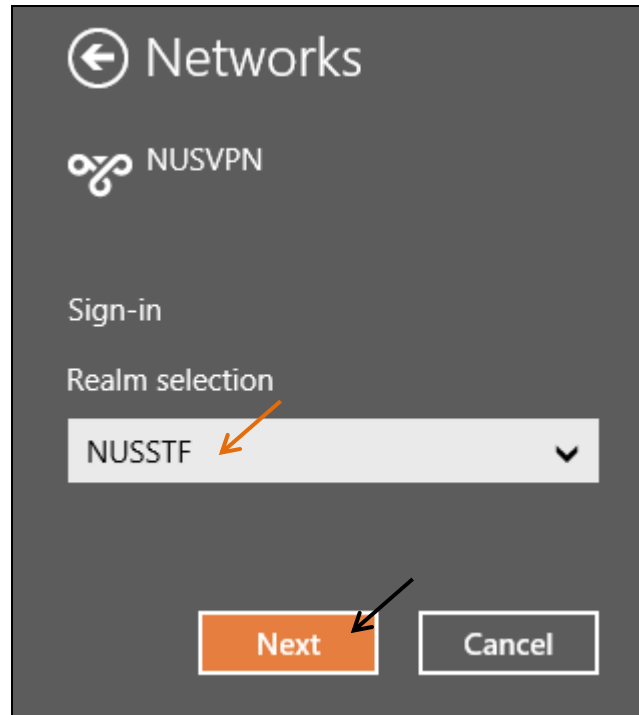


9. Select the appropriate NUS domain under **Realm selection** and click **Next**.

NUSSTF: for staff

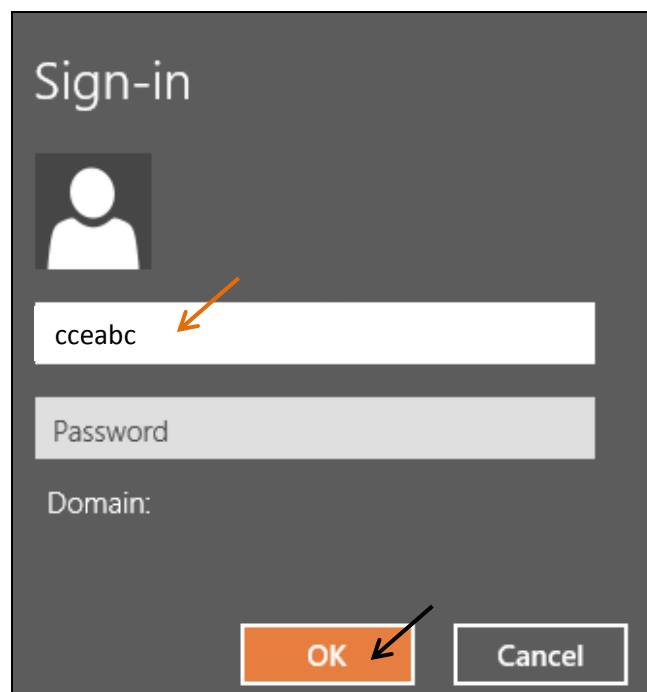
NUSSTU: for students

10. Enter your NUSNET User ID and Password.

Click **OK**.



11. Once successful, it will get connected to NUS VPN.

To disconnect, simply click on the connection and select "Disconnect".
