### PROPOSITION

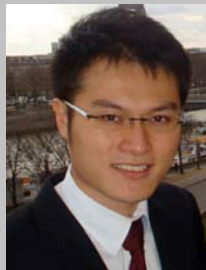
#### Hendrik Cluver, MBA, NTU
