<p>FASStrack Asia: The Summer School (June to July) http://www.fas.nus.edu.sg/fasstrack/</p>	<p>Students can read up to 2 courses offered by Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences Asian Studies Division and the Social Sciences Division. Some of these courses will feature 8-10 days' field trip to the country of study and some offer local day trips in Singapore to facilitate experiential learning outside the classroom. There are opportunities to study relevant Asian language courses that will complement the field trips for a comprehensive learning experience and in-depth cultural immersion.</p>
