

## Information for Students on Exchange

<b>A. University</b>	<b>Zhejiang University</b>  <a href="http://www.zju.edu.cn/english/">http://www.zju.edu.cn/english/</a>  Zhejiang University (ZJU), located in the historical and picturesque city of Hangzhou, is a prestigious institution of higher education with a long history. ZJU is a comprehensive research university with distinctive features and a national as well as international impact. It is also a member of the C9 League of universities in China.

<b>C. Academics</b>	
<b>i) Module Mapping &amp; Credits Transfer</b>	SEP students can transfer 20 MCs back to NUS if they have taken a full semester of workload at the host university with effect from AY2016/17.  Please check with your SEP co-ordinator at your Faculty for more information.
<b>ii) Academic Calendar</b>	<b>Semester 1:</b> September to January <b>Semester 2:</b> February to July
<b>iii) Exchange Duration</b>	One semester or Full-Year exchange, depending on your home Faculty.
<b>iv) Examination</b>	Students are expected to sit for the mandatory examinations at Zhejiang University before returning to NUS for the next semester.
<b>v) Curriculum Structure</b>	Full-degree undergraduate students at ZJU are required to get a minimum of 15 credits per semester and a total of 169 credits during their 4-5 years study programme. 1 credit at ZJU is equivalent to 16 teaching hours. Currently, ZJU does not have any credit requirements for exchange students.
<b>vi) Entry Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• be enrolled at the National University of Singapore (NUS) as a full-time student;</li> <li>• have completed at least two semesters of study before embarking on the exchange programme;</li> <li>• have a sound academic record, i.e. minimum CAP of 3.0, and should not have any grade below grade 'C' (grade point of 2.0) in any module;</li> <li>• have sufficient financial means to cover the necessary expenses for the duration of the SEP (ranging from S\$5,000 to S\$15,000 per semester, subject to the country and local conditions at the overseas Partner University during the period of exchange). When applying for your student visa, a number of countries may demand documentary proof of your financial status;</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• obtain the Faculty's approval for the SEP;</li> <li>• satisfy partner institution and host country entry requirements; and</li> <li>• check with the issuer of any scholarship he or she is receiving to ensure there are no restrictions involving overseas study (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Ministry of Education).</li> </ul>										
<b>vii) Language Proficiency Requirements</b>	<p>Mandarin is the medium of instruction for classes at the host university (with limited English modules). NUS students with Chinese background may be exempted from the HSK Chinese language proficiency requirements to read Chinese courses at Zhejiang University.</p>

<b>i) Procedures</b>	<p>Please apply via your home Faculty for SEP to Zhejiang University. Only if you have been offered a SEP placement by your Faculty and you have accepted the internal offer, you will be informed to apply to Zhejiang University directly.</p> <p>Exchange students who have accepted internal offer to Zhejiang University are required to submit an online application before 15 Nov for spring/summer semester and before 10 May for autumn/winter semester and email the supporting documents to ZJU's SEP coordinator in one pdf file before the application deadline.</p>	
<b>ii) Deadlines</b>	Please check with your SEP Administrator in the Dean's Office for actual dates.	
<b>E. Accommodations</b>		
<b>i) University Accommodation</b>	ZJU will assist exchange students for on-campus accommodation reservation at the International College at the cost of around CN¥1500 per person per month on twin sharing basis. Exchange students will be arranged to stay in at the dorm for international students where the respective College/Department is located. Exchange students are usually allowed to check in within three days before the date of registration. A CN¥800 refundable room deposit is required upon checking-in.

<b>Consular/Visa Regulation</b>	Exchange students in China are required to apply for student visa (X2 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of no more than 180 days	

	<p>and X1 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of more than 180 days).</p> <p>You will receive the admission letter and visa application form (JW202) once you are accepted by the host university for the student exchange programme.
