1	Programme Fee	Fellows at ETH Zurich will receive a monthly allowance of about CHF 1750 to cover housing and living expenses. Travel and visa expenses will be covered as well. Students can claim the travel costs against receipts at the beginning of the program.	
2	Projected Expenditure	Please take note that there may be additional expenses which you have to pay for visa (if applicable), flight, food and your leisure activity while on i-RAP.

4	Academic Content	Fellows will pursue a research project that aligns with a chosen area of their interest as part of a research group in the department of Computer Science. Students will be assigned to a group in an area of your choice. Please refer to the list of <u>research areas</u> .
5	Eligibility Requirements	The programme is highly competitive as ETH Zurich offers very limited places. NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see GRO website for details.
6	Accommodation	Affordable housing during the research stay will be organized, once a candidate is accepted into the programme.
7	Application Procedure at NUS	Please apply via EduRec and the host university's website concurrently . You must accept both EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme. With an official application through EduRec, you are covered by the NUS Travel Blanket Insurance. Besides, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for



		visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen). Read the step-by-step guide which we have prepared for you on GRO's web.
8	Application Procedure at Host University	Prior to starting your application please read the "How to apply" information on the programme website and prepare all required documents: https://www.inf.ethz.ch/studies/summer-research-fellowship To apply you need to register with SiROP. Use "Register" in the menu (https://sirop.org/app/register with SiROP. Use "Register" in the menu (https://sirop.org/app/register with SiROP. After logging in you can return to the SiROP page and you will find the button "Apply now" at the top.
9	Confirmation of participation	You will be informed by the host university via email about your acceptance or rejection. You have to accept EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme. Please read the cancellation policy of this programme before accepting and paying for the programme.
10	Module Mapping	All mapping requests are subjected to approval by the Faculties/Departments. If you are interested in obtaining credits, you can start the module mapping process after you have accepted the offer for the programme via EduRec. Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 MCs for involvement in summer programme. Beyond 12MCs, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university.
