Data Analytics (https://www.itba.edu.ar/data-analytics/) This course presents the fundamentals of data analysis and visualization. It introduces all the necessary concepts like database modeling and design, SQL, business intelligence, multidimensional databases and non-SQL databases.</p>

Also note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum of 2 modules (up to 10 MCs) can be mapped per summer / research programme during Special Term (May – August). • Maximum of 1 module (up to 5 MCs) can be mapped per winter / research programme during year-end vacation (December – January). <p>Total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition.
