4	Academic Content	You have the option to take either of the modules:	
		1. Argentine Culture ( <a href="https://www.itba.edu.ar/argentine-culture/">https://www.itba.edu.ar/argentine-culture/</a> )	
		The course will give students an overview of Argentine history and	
		culture. Each week, one class will be dedicated to approaching	
		Argentina through a specific lens: geography, literature, visual arts,	
		and popular culture. Each lens will provide a view into different	
		moments, spaces, topics and social actors. The remainder of the	

		classes will loosely draw a timeline throughout Argentine history, from the pre-Columbian period to date, providing a closer look into significant events and public figures that have shaped the Argentine identity.  2. Data Analytics ( <a href="https://www.itba.edu.ar/data-analytics/">https://www.itba.edu.ar/data-analytics/</a> ) This course presents the fundamentals of data analysis and visualization. It introduces all the necessary concepts like database modeling and design, SQL, business intelligence, multidimensional databases and non-SQL databases.

6	Accommodation	Housing is provided under the programme fees, and you will be staying with host families.

8	Module Mapping	You can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping. Also note the following:  • Maximum of 2 modules (up to 10 MCs) can be mapped per summer / research programme during Special Term (May – August).  • Maximum of 1 module (up to 5 MCs) can be mapped per winter / research programme during year-end vacation (December – January).  Total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.
