Within the four weeks, students can attend four courses• Austrian Students' Union fee (ÖH-Beitrag), including accident and liability insurance• Use of all campus facilities (e.g. library, study room, computer room, WLAN, Bürglhaus bar, Sehausstüberl, etc.).• Handouts, scripts and other relevant teaching material.• Accommodation and the entire board for the four weeks. 3	Financial Aid Available Through Sommerhochschule	<p>A limited number of partial scholarships ranging from € 1,000 to € 3,000 are available for the European Studies section of the univie: summer school.</p> <p>The remaining amount to cover the sum of € 4,407.40 (€ 2,590 Summer school fee, € 24.70 Austrian students' union fee, plus € 1,792.70 double room accommodation and full board) must be paid by the applicant.</p> <p>The scholarships are awarded based on academic excellence and financial need. Students must demonstrate their financial need by describing their financial situation and submitting related documents.</p> <p>The scholarship application deadline is 28 February 2025. 4	Financial Aid Available Through NUS GRO	<p>You should have enough monetary funds to cover the whole SWP. Your decision to go on SWP should not depend on confirmation of a scholarship or bursary award. You can consider the following financial aid options to fund your SWP:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NASA Enhancement Bursary (Singaporean Citizens only) • Overseas Student Programme Loan (Singaporeans only) • Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA) Ad-Hoc Withdrawal (Singaporeans only) <p>Please note that if you are successful with any financial aid, the funds will only be disbursed to you after completion of the Programme.</p>	

PROGRAMME DETAILS

5	Academic Content	<p>The Sommerhochschule European Studies program offers 13 courses and consists of two two-week sessions. Six European Studies courses are offered during the first and seven during the second session. The European Studies courses focus on the emerging New Europe. They cover political, economic, and legal aspects as well as historical and cultural aspects of the multiple transformations the continent is currently undergoing. The programme thus offers a concise and up-to-date introduction to recent developments in Europe, which will provide students from different fields of study with additional key qualifications for future professional work.</p> <p>The schedule contains a list of courses and timetables. It is suitable for students interested in EU Law, European Studies, and German Language courses.</p>

		<p>The allocation of the ECTS credits to the SHS courses is based on the amount of work necessary for each course. The SHS grants 4 ECTS credits for each course in the European Studies section and 6 ECTS credits per German language course.</p> <p>The offered courses have the following contact hours:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - European Studies courses = 32 contact hours - German courses = 64 contact hours <p>Final examinations are given in all courses. Regular classroom attendance is mandatory for all courses. Students absent from classes without leave will not be graded. NUS students must sit for the examination, pass the courses and get a graded transcript before credits can be transferred back to NUS.</p> <p>Students may also enrol or audit additional courses. The maximum number of courses students may attend during the summer programme is 4 (this includes German courses and/or courses taken for audit). Students who successfully attend and complete four courses will receive the SHS Diploma in European Studies.</p>
6	Eligibility Requirements	<p>SHS's requirements are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants must be at least 18 years old • Have completed at least 2 years of studies at NUS • Must be in attendance for the whole period of the univie: summer school, be able to take part in the required number of courses • English language proficiency—Proof of this fact will be sufficient for students who have studied for at least one year at a university where the language of instruction is English. <p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see the GRO website for details.</p>
7	Accommodation	<p>Please refer to the host university website for accommodation arrangements. If university-arranged accommodation is unavailable, you will be responsible for securing your own.</p> <p>Information on the accommodation offered by the host university is available at https://international.au.dk/education/admissions/summeruniversity/housing</p>
8	Application Procedure at NUS	<p>Please apply through the NUS Education Records System - Global Education (EduRec-GE) first if you want to do module mapping and apply for financial aid/loans. Applying through EduRec-GE will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while overseas.</p> <p>With an official application through EduRec-GE, you are covered by the NUS Travel Blanket Insurance. Besides, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application. Read the step-by-step guide we prepared for you on GRO's website.</p>

		You should also concurrently apply to the host university once you have applied to NUS Edu-Rec.
9	Application Procedure at Host University	<p>Details of the application procedures and the list of supporting documents can be found here.</p> <p>All documents must be submitted in original or as a certified copy to SHS. Please note that applications will not be reviewed until all required materials have been received. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.</p> <p>Applicants must pay a deposit of € 400 when applying for summer school.</p>
10	Confirmation of participation	<p>To confirm your participation in this programme, you must accept the EduRec-GE offer and the host university offer.</p> <p>After SHS receives the total programme fee, the applicant will be informed via email and receive a payment confirmation and/or an official invitation letter (which might be needed for visa applications) via regular mail.</p> <p><u>Cancellation & Refund</u> Please read the Sommerhochschule Cancellation and Refund Policy on the University of Vienna website.</p>
11	Course Mapping	<p>All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments.</p> <p>If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. Please read the information on the Office of the University Registrar's website for details.</p>
12	Transcript	<p>Please provide a valid, personal mailing address in the online registration portal so the host can send your transcript to you after the summer programme.</p> <p>Please do not request that your transcript be mailed to the NUS Global Relations Office (GRO). GRO is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>
