5	Academic	The Sommerhochschule European Studies program offers 13 courses and
	Content	consists of two two-week sessions . Six European Studies courses are offered
		during the first and seven during the second session. The European Studies
		courses focus on the emerging New Europe. They cover political, economic, and legal aspects as well as historical and cultural aspects of the multiple transformations the continent is currently undergoing. The programme thus offers a concise and up-to-date introduction to recent developments in Europe, which will provide students from different fields of study with additional key qualifications for future professional work.
		The schedule contains a list of courses and timetables. It is suitable for students interested in EU Law, European Studies, and German Language courses.



		The allocation of the ECTS credits to the SHS courses is based on the amount of work necessary for each course. The SHS grants 4 ECTS credits for each course in the European Studies section and 6 ECTS credits per German language course. The offered courses have the following contact hours: - European Studies courses = 32 contact hours - German courses = 64 contact hours Final examinations are given in all courses. Regular classroom attendance is mandatory for all courses. Students absent from classes without leave will not be graded. NUS students must sit for the examination, pass the courses and get a graded transcript before credits can be transferred back to NUS. Students may also enrol or audit additional courses. The maximum number of courses students may attend during the summer programme is 4 (this includes German courses and/or courses taken for audit). Students who successfully attend and complete four courses will 3 receive the SHS Diploma in European Studies.

		Applicants must pay a deposit of € 400 when applying for summer school.	
10	Confirmation of participation	To confirm your participation in this programme, you must accept the EduRec-GE offer and the host university offer.	
		After SHS receives the total programme fee, the applicant will be informed via email and receive a payment confirmation and/or an official invitation letter (which might be needed for visa applications) via regular mail.

11	Course Mapping	All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments.	
		If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer.	
		Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. Please read the information on the Office of the University Registrar's website for details.
