Programme fee includes:

Some VSP course packages include socio-cultural activities that are included in the programme fee, while other activities are partly subsidized or come at an additional cost. For example, students may be responsible for the cost of public transportation for all off-campus classes and field trips.

4	Academic Content	Each student will take up one themed course package in a wide variety of academic disciplines available. Each course package comprises of two relevant courses taught by world-class UBC Faculty instructors. Each course is approximately 39 hours of instructional time that includes practical and theoretical learning. Students will earn a certificate and grades letter upon successful completion of the program.
		(Please note: VSP course packages do not carry UBC credits. Students have to complete the course mapping process in NUS to seek approval for awarding of units. Refer to Item 8 for more details.)

after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course



mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping. vAlso note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools. A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.
