D. Exchange Duration	One semester
E. Application Requirement	NUS International students must submit an official transcript showing a minimum of two years of completed study at NUS at the time of application with ANU to be considered for exchange at ANU.
F. Course Information	<p>Exchange students need to study a full course load of 24 ANU units per semester (typically 4 courses at 6 units each). Students can apply to undertake a reduced study load of 18 units; with approval from home university and ANU.</p> <p>Please note that the maximum workload is 24 units per semester.</p> <p>The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 24 units. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.</p> <p>ANU's teaching system is a combination of lectures, tutorials and laboratory classes. The amount of time students spend in classes will vary depending on the course. A full-time student should be prepared to spend 40-45 hours of study per week.</p> <p>Restricted courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Courses offered by the ANU Medical School are not available, these courses that are unavailable typically begin with code MEDI and MEDN. • Art studio, music, and design courses are limited. • Law courses are only available to students who are enrolled in a law degree at their home institution. • All students must meet the prerequisite requirements for the courses they wish to take <p>Course information: https://programsandcourses.anu.edu.au/search</p>

G. Accommodation	<p>On-campus housing is guaranteed for exchange students, however, please note that preferences for student accommodation cannot be guaranteed. Students must meet the relevant application deadlines to be eligible.</p> <p>Please refer to the information provided by ANU for latest updates regarding housing availability.</p> <p>Accommodation options: https://study.anu.edu.au/accommodation</p>
H. Visa	<p>Once you have purchased the Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC), your host university will issue an Electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE), which is required for your Australian student visa application.</p> <p>All exchange students must hold a current visa which entitles them to study for the full duration of their programme. Typically, this is a subclass 500 student visa and student should obtain the visa before arriving in Australia.</p> <p>Students are advised to apply for the necessary visa immediately after they received the official offer letter/email from their host university. This is to ensure that you can obtain your visa in time before the start of your exchange term. Your exchange at the host university depends on the clearance by the immigration of the host country.</p> <p>All visas are subject to conditions and students must ensure they always comply with the conditions of their visa.</p> <p>For more information on visa applications, please refer to https://immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas/getting-a-visa/visa-listing/student-500.</p>
I. Insurance	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/</p> <p>All international students studying in Australia are required to purchase an approved Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) policy. OSHC is compulsory requirement for obtaining an Australian subclass 500 (student) visa. Students can purchase OSHC through your host university. Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs.</p>
