Application Requirement	Non-Chinese nationality (including Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macao passport holders)
Language Proficiency Requirement	Mandarin is the medium of instruction for classes at the host university (with limited English-taught courses). NUS students with Chinese language background may be exempted from the HSK Chinese language proficiency requirements to read Chinese-taught courses at Nanjing University.
Course Information	Exchange students are expected to take at least 3 courses each semester. Course credits range from 2 to 4 NJU credits. One NJU credit equals to 16 hours of study. The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 13 credits. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer. 	Please note that there are limited English-taught courses at NJU and course offering is subject to change from time to time. Exchange students could approach NJU Office of International Cooperation and Exchanges for assistance on courses in NJU and requests for cross faculty courses after registration upon arrival.
Accommodation	All the exchange students are recommended to live in Xianlin campus. Standard single and double rooms are available, each room is equipped with telephone lines, private bathrooms, television and air-conditioning. Due to the limited room availability, students are highly recommended to opt for double rooms.

Visa	Exchange students are required to apply for student visa (X2 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of no more than 180 days and X1 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of more than 180 days).
	You will receive the admission letter and visa application form (JW202) once you are accepted by the host university for the student exchange programme. Exchange students from Singapore are required to apply for the student visa in person at the China Visa Application Service Centre in Singapore with the relevant documents before the start of the academic semester.

Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. Exchange Students must have comprehensive health insurance valid in China for enrolment as a full-time student at NJU. Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs.
