<b>University</b>	University of Copenhagen
<b>Country</b>	Denmark

<b>Exchange Duration</b>	One semester. Students are encouraged to go for exchange in Semester 2 due to the overlap in academic calendar.
<b>Language Proficiency Requirement</b>	<p>The language of instruction is Danish/English. <b>Course Information</b>	<p>The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 30 ECTS. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the <a href="#">SEP Credit Transfer Calculator</a> for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. <b>Visa</b>	<p>Exchange students who are non-EU/EEA nationals are required to apply for a residence permit from the <a href="#">Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration (SIRI)</a> for their studies before the arrival in Denmark.</p> <p>Upon admission, UCPH will send students the residence permit/visa application form with application instructions. If you did not receive the form 2 weeks after the admission, please contact UCPH at <a href="mailto:INT-admission@adm.ku.dk">INT-admission@adm.ku.dk</a>. <b>DO NOT</b> start an online residence permit/visa application.</p>
<b>Insurance</b>	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident &amp; Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to <a href="https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/">https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/</a>.</p> <p>The Danish healthcare system covers international students at the UCPH who are staying in Denmark for more than three months. Exchange students will be covered by the Danish Health Insurance once they have received a CPR number: <a href="https://studies.ku.dk/living-in-copenhagen/health-and-safety-in-denmark/">https://studies.ku.dk/living-in-copenhagen/health-and-safety-in-denmark/</a>.</p> <p>It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within/outside Denmark. Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs.</p> <p>Students are strongly encouraged to assess the risk of their intended activities and purchase supplemental insurance plans to ensure they are adequately covered during their time abroad.</p>
