Academic Calendar	Semester 1 (Fall): early September to end of January/mid-February (depending on programme) Semester 2 (Spring): mid-February to May (extended to September with internships)
Exchange Duration	One semester
Language Proficiency Requirement	Programme in French Mines Paris-PSL require a level higher or equivalent to an advanced B1. Official certificates such as TEF: 361; DELF: B1; TCF: 300 are accepted as well as those provided by our partner universities.
	Programme in English Mines Paris-PSL require a level higher or equivalent to a B2. As proof they accept official certificates such as TOEIC, TOEFL, Cambridge and those provided by partner universities.
Course Information	This study programme must include at least 20 ECTS and maximum 30 ECTS per semester.
	The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 30 ECTS credits. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.

Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/ .
	Health insurance is compulsory. All students must show proof of health insurance coverage for the duration of their stay at Mines Paris (i.e. a European health insurance card, etc.). Student health insurance in France is free but every student should register on: https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/ . International students should also be covered with a civil liability insurance for physical injury or material damages caused by the students. This insurance is provided by Mines Paris.
