Course Information	The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 24 credits. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.
Accommodation	Housing is not guaranteed for students. Visa	Singapore citizens do not require a visa to travel to Mexico for a period of entry not exceeding 180 days and for non-gainful activities (tourist). Please check your visa requirement and the latest advice on visa regulations from the Embassy of Mexico in Singapore. https://embamex.sre.gob.mx/singapur/index.php/consular-services/visas <i>Note: All students are advised to apply for the necessary visa immediately after they receive the official offer letter/email and instructions from their host university. Some visa applications can take up to 2 months to process. Your exchange at the host university depends on the clearance by the immigration of the host country.</i>
Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/ . In addition, students will be required to enrol in the compulsory health insurance policy or scheme at their SEP host university. Tec de Monterrey requires all international students to have an international health insurance with specific coverages and amounts during their stay.
