Course Information	Workload requirement varies between academic departments but average is: 48 CATS (24 ECTS) (3 or 4 modules) per term. The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is 48-60 Warwick CATS. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the SEP Credit Transfer Calculator for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.
