<b>Exchange Duration</b>	One semester
Course Information	<ul> <li>12-15 credits per semester (approximately 4-5 classes)</li> <li>Maximum workload is 16 credits per semester</li> </ul>
	The regular semester workload for full-time undergraduate students as determined by the Office of the Provost is <b>15</b> credits. Credits earned at the host university may not be directly equivalent to NUS credits and you can refer to the <u>SEP Credit Transfer Calculator</u> for information on units exchange ratio at the host university. Please note that the actual number of credits earned is subject to the units exchange ratio at the point of credit transfer.
Accommodation	Housing is not guaranteed but available. Students who live on campus are required to purchase a meal plan

	Note: All students are advised to apply for the necessary visa immediately after they receive the official offer letter/email and instructions from their host university. Some visa applications can take up to 2 months to process. Your exchange at the host university depends on the clearance by the immigration of the host country.
Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance.
