SINGAPORE: More than half a million dollars has so far been collected for the Yusof Ishak Professorship at the National University of Singapore. The professorship will enable research in areas of multiethnic and religious diversity for a more inclusive society.

This was announced by the SG50Kita committee on Friday (Jan 30), which aims to raise S\$6 million by the end of this year.

SG50Kita and the Malay community will also celebrate the nation's golden jubilee with a series of programmes where Singaporeans can acknowledge the past, celebrate the present and care for the future, with its focus of "caring, sharing and giving".

One of the programmes is dedicated specially for youths - titled ${\sf SG50Kita}\ {\sf X}.$
