Malay groups celebrate SG50

To mark Singapore's 50th birthday, the Malay/Muslim community will be spearheading a series of programmes this year called SG50Kita.

In Malay, "Kita" means "us".

One of the upcoming activities is Kita X, a four-month-long programme starting in March. About 100 young people will develop solutions to the problems of a Singapore 50 years in the future.

SG50Kita will also be raising funds for the Yusof Ishak Professorship in Social Sciences at the National University of Singapore.

Various Malay/Muslim organisations will join in a week of community service projects in June, during the fasting month of Ramadan.
