

Singapore Exchange

Professor Hans Tjio has been redesignated the deputy chairman of the Listings Advisory Committee (LAC) and Mr Goh Kian Hwee has been appointed as a member of the LAC with effect from yesterday.

The LAC is a panel of market professionals that the Singapore Exchange (SGX) can draw upon for views on its listing policies. Last year, the LAC advised on SGX's proposed listing framework for dual class share structures.

The appointments were made in consultation with the Monetary Authority of Singapore.

Prof Tjio, who joined the LAC on Feb 1 last year, is taking over from Prof Tan Cheng Han, following Prof Tan's appointment as the chairman of the newly established Singapore Exchange Regulation.

Prof Tjio has taught at the National University of Singapore's Faculty of Law since 1990 and is the co-director of the faculty's Centre for Banking and Finance Law.

Mr Goh is the executive director of QAF, and an independent director of CapitaLand Commercial Trust Management.
