Volunteers injected with locally co-developed Covid-19 vaccine

The first cohort of local volunteers has been dosed with a coronavirus vaccine jointly developed by Duke-NUS Medical School and United States pharmaceutical company Arcturus Therapeutics.

Arcturus said on Tuesday that this first phase of the trial involved volunteers aged between 21 and 55 who were injected with a single shot of the vaccine.
