

3.3.3.1 NYU-NUS LLB-LLM Exchange Plus Programme

Exchange Plus Programme [LLB (Hons) / Graduate LLB (Hons)] & Masters of Law (LLM)

The LLB-LLM programme allows current NUS Law students in the four-year LLB programme to seek early admission to the Masters in Law (LLM) at New York University (NYU) School of Law and commence the LLM in their fourth year of studies at NUS, before graduating with the LLB. The credits read at NYU towards the LLM will count towards the NUS LLB degree. Upon completion of the LLM requirements, students will receive the NUS LLB (Hons) and the NYU LLM. Students on the three-year Graduate LLB programme can also seek admission and commence the LLM in their second semester of their third year of studies to receive both degrees. They will complete two and a half years at NUS and one year at NYU to fulfill the programme requirements.
