The overseas summer research programme gives students an opportunity to conduct research in the world's leading institutions, over the May to August NUS break.

Students will work under the mentorship of outstanding researchers, and experience the challenges and rewards that come from pursuing an independent research project in a different environment. These programmes, available in Asia, the Americas and Europe, are generally eight to twelve weeks long, and are offered in various areas/disciplines.
