3. NUS Application Number (an 8-digit number given to the applicant after he/she has applied for undergraduate admissions to NUS)

Please note that you have to complete and submit the report in one sitting, as the report cannot be saved before submission. Please ensure that all the information is correct before submitting, as you will not be able to edit the report after submission.
