The delegations comprises of 100 outstanding university students from around the world, together with 40 leaders of business, political and academic areas.

The topic for the 2008 SABF is "Empowering Agents of Change". Delegates will analyze the existing change agents in the world, particularly those which have become blurred in South America, with the objective of finding out the causes of their lack of involvement and finding solutions to achieve their goals.

During the three-day conference, students will be able to interact with peers from around the world, as well as with prominent leaders of the academic, business and political spheres, debating on several current issues related to the region. The Forum will provide an opportunity to experience an unique and enriching cultural exchange with fellow participants.

All applicants are to submit their personal information and upload an essay of your authorship on any one of the three topics that emerge from the central theme: "Institutions as the foundations for a favorable environment", "Entrepreneurial Cultures: their impact on emerging regions" and "The intelligent use of resources as a means of development".

Selection of the best 100 students are based on the presentation of the essay submitted. Conference costs will be covered for the selected students except for the travel costs to and from Buenos Aires. Selected students may write in to Office of Student Affairs (email: activity@nus.edu.sg) to apply for subsidy for travel costs.
