STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS 2009

The Student Achievement Awards are given out annually to recognise exceptional individuals or student groups who have made significant contributions beyond their academic curriculum, and brought honour to the University for Academic Year 08/09.

Eligibility

- Nominees must be currently studying at or have recently graduated from the University
- Nominees must obtain at least a CAP of 2.0
- Nominees are to be nominated for achievements between 4 August 2008 to 2 August 2009
- Nominees must not have committed any major disciplinary offence
- Nominees must not have flouted any major University guidelines governing student activities, e.g. Financial Guidelines, during the period of evaluation

Categories (Individual and Group)

Distinguished Leadership
Arts and Culture
Community Projects
Competitions

General Selection Criteria

Nominees for the individual or group awards will be assessed on :

- Level of involvement and University representation
- Scale and impact of contribution to the field and campus vibrancy
- Creativity

Other Specific Selection Criteria

Distinguished Leadership

- Encourages students' participation in campus activities
- Drives major project committees or initiatives

Arts and Culture

- Includes music, fine arts, visual media and performances
- Integrates various ethnic and cultural groups

Community Projects

- Includes humanitarian and environmental activities
- Duration of project and sustainability

Competitions

- Includes business case, debate, entrepreneurship, technology and moot court competitions
- Excludes sports
- Achieved top three placing at the national or regional level, or were finalists in international competitions
