REVISED HALL ADMISSION POINTS SYSTEM

1. CATEGORIES AND LEVELS

- There are 5 categories of activities with different levels of participation.

CATEGORIES	LEVELS OF PARTICIPATION
Category 1 : Organisational	Hall, NUSSU, Clubs, Societies
Category 2 : Arts / Culture	National, NUS, Hall, Faculty / Club, Society, Block
Category 3 : Sports / National Events	National, NUS, Hall, Faculty / Club, Society, Block
Category 4 : Community Service	National, NUS, Hall, Faculty / Club, Society, Block
Category 5 : Academic / Debate / Quiz	National, NUS, Hall, Faculty / Club, Society, Block

- Points will be awarded for community service according to the time duration of the participation.

2. DEFINITIONS

- *Faculty / Club* refers to the Students' Union's 11 Faculty Clubs and 4 Non-Faculty Clubs.
- *Society* refers to the University's Student Groups which are registered with the Registrar of Societies. However, only Societies approved by the Office of Student Affairs will be recognised for the award of the CCA points.

3. FORMULATION FOR PARTICIPATION

Each category will be given a maximum of 20 to 40 points, depending on the number of categories participated.

4. ACTIVITIES

When categorizing the organizational activities according to the committees, do follow the 3:4:3 ratio (3 Major : 4 Intermediate : 3 Minor). The number of major or minor activities should not exceed the number of intermediate activities.

The maximum number of activities which can be included for CCA points computation for Hall Admission is 8. These 8 activities may be distributed among all categories.

5. PERFORMANCE POINTS (Allocation of points is by respective Presidents according to Member's Performance)

- Organisational Category

Organisations may award performance points (Bonus/Demerit) for participation in Executive (± 2), Major (± 2), Intermediate (± 1) and Minor (± 0.5) Committees. All points are awarded by Organisations.

Bonus Points may be awarded to outstanding participants (top 5 – 10%).

Demerit Points can be given as penalties for unsatisfactory performance.

- Arts/Culture and Sports Categories

Demerit Points can be given for unsatisfactory performance. The maximum demerit points which can be given are :

National / NUS / Hall (- 3), Faculty / Club / Society (- 2) and Block (- 1).

6. HALL ADMISSION 2ND YEAR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

All second year international students who apply will be offered housing.

7. MINIMUM HALL PARTICIPATION POINTS FOR 2ND – 5TH YEAR INTERNATIONAL / LOCAL STUDENTS

For re-admission of	Student Type	Min Hall Points	Earned during
2 nd year students	Old Seniors	8 points	1 st year stay
3 rd / 4 th / 5 th year students	Old Seniors	12 points	2 nd to 4 th year stay

- 2nd year students must earn a minimum of **8** hall participation points (from non-Block activities) during their 1st year to apply for re-admission into the Halls for their 2nd year of stay
- 3rd – 5th year students must offer a minimum of **12** Hall participation points for Hall re-admission, earned during their previous year of stay.

8. HOUSING FOR OFFICE BEARERS

The following will be offered housing as their heavy commitments will not permit them to compete on CCA points :

9. HALL HOPPING (This is only applicable to students staying in halls)

Residents seeking re-admission into another hall will automatically incur a reduction of 50% of their acquired hall points. The reduction does not apply to points acquired through non-hall activities.
