**Notes:**

1. UE 1 and UE 2 must be outside the disciplines of both Economics and Law.
2. Only two of the non-EC modules taken in Year 1 are required for fulfilling the DDP. Assuming a normal workload (40MC) for Year 1, the student will lag behind by 8MC when they reach the 4<sup>th</sup> year. If they wish to complete the DDP within 5 years, they will have to handle a heavier-than-normal workload for some semesters. This suggested sequence shows 24MC semesters for Year 4.
