AFTER BEING OFFERED ADMISSION (COURSEWORK IN SPECIAL TERM)

ACCEPT/ DECLINE OFFER

by logging into the application portal on <https://myapplications.nus.edu.sg>

- You will need to upload your photo upon accepting your offer. See the photo requirements on <https://tinyurl.com/lrvk9zg>

The photo will be printed on your student card.
You will receive an acknowledgment email thereafter.

- Wait at least one week as indicated in the Registration Guide (<https://tinyurl.com/wotmrzm>) before starting on Registration Part One.

- Within two weeks of receiving offer email

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STUDENT'S PASS APPLICATION

- Does not apply to Singapore Citizens and PRs

At least one month before start of semester, Registrar's Office will send application instructions to your personal email.

- Please check that all the details are correct before submitting your application on SOLAR (<https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/solar/index.xhtml>).
- Make payment for processing fees (SGD30). After the application is approved, make payment for issuance fees (SGD60) and (if applicable) multi-journey visa fees (SGD30).

- End March to Early May

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REGISTRATION PART ONE

by logging into the system on <https://myregistration.nus.edu.sg> with your application number and application password. You will receive your NUSNET ID, Student ID and a default password upon completion.

- Reset your NUSNET default password on <https://exchange.nus.edu.sg/passwordportal> two days after completing this step.

Most communications from the university to student will be via the official NUS email account. Check your NUS email (<https://outlook.com/nu.nus.edu>) regularly.

*** If your period of study extends to Semester 1 of the following academic year, Miscellaneous Student Fees and tuition fees for Semester 1 shall be payable.**

^ Payment of Tuition Fees (for non-exchange students) can be done after Instructional Week 2. Please check your Student Bill for the final amount.

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REGISTRATION PART TWO

- Please report for registration at the Registrar's Office **1 week before the official start date***
Special Term (Part 1) officially starts on 11 May 2020;
Special Term (Part 2) officially starts on 22 June 2020

All students are to bring this document on Registration Day: Passport or Identity Card
Students below 18 years old also bring:

- (1) Risk Acknowledgment and Consent Form
- (2) Authorization of Medical Procedures (for international students only)
- (3) Appointment of Local Representative (for international students only)

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COMPLETION OF FORMALITIES FOR STUDENT'S PASS

Refer to your In-Principle Approval (IPA) Letter for the documents to be submitted at your appointment. Book an e-appointment at <https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/iibook/index.do> before arrival with your credentials as indicated on your IPA letter.

Go to the ICA Building @ 10 Kallang Road, Beside Lavender MRT at the appointed time.
