1. For **ALL** applicants:

- Passport showing your particulars**, with an expiry date that is valid until the completion of studies at NUS (for non-Singapore Citizens)
- Official Academic Transcript(s), including the grade legend** issued by the Home University (with English translation, if applicable). The transcript must be endorsed with the university's seal and official signatory or a verification link.
- Record of courses taken in current semester/term**

2. For applicants who wish to be admitted as **research students**:

- Agreement from the NUS proposed supervisor** – *This can be in the form of an email or a letter.*
- Letter of support from Home University's research supervisor with his/her contact details**
- Detailed training [plan](#)**
- Curriculum vitae with publication list, if any**

3. Other supporting documents (if applicable):

- Detailed course syllabus or links to online course syllabus** for courses that are pre-requisites to NUS modules (both completed and current courses) – *Recommended for applicants who wish to read modules with pre-requisites.*
- Letter** from the **Home University** certifying the applicant's level of proficiency in the foreign language – *For applicants who wish to read language modules in NUS (with prefix 'LA' e.g. LAC/LAF/LAG, etc.).*
- Letter from the **Home University** stating the year of design module applicants should be enrolled in during their exchange at NUS (e.g. Year 1, 2, 3, 4) – *For applicants who wish to read Architecture Design modules in NUS.*

Non-Exchange Students (Not Nominated by a [Partner University](#) / Not From a Partner University)

Scanned / Softcopy documents to be uploaded (where applicable) via the [NG Application System](#). **In addition, all documents (except passport) are required to be posted in hard copy to NUS Registrar's Office. Tuition fees are applicable for Non-Exchange Students.**

1. For **ALL** applicants:

- Passport showing your particulars**, with an expiry date that is valid until the completion of studies at NUS (for non-Singapore Citizens)
- Official Academic Transcript(s), including the grade legend** issued by the Home University (with English translation, if applicable). Only original academic transcripts of degree programs completed and/or currently in progress will be accepted. The transcript must be endorsed with the university's seal and official signatory. Original hard copy will not be returned to the applicant.
- Record of courses taken in current semester/term**
- Student status letter from Home University** indicating your expected graduate date/month and current student status in the University;
- Documentary proof of financial support in English** certifying financial ability to make payment for the Miscellaneous Student Fees (MSFs) and tuition fees for at least 3 modules or research fee.
 - *Self-financing student*. Submit a bank statement (original, certified true copy or electronically generated statements will be accepted). The statement should not be dated more than 6 months from the intended date of admission.
 - *Scholarship holder*. Submit an official letter from the sponsoring organization(s) with details of the sponsorship over the period of study/research at NUS.
- Copy of a valid **TOEFL/IELTS test scores** – For applicants who wish to do coursework and are from non-English medium universities.

2. For applicants who wish to be admitted as **research students**:

- Agreement from the NUS proposed supervisor** – *This can be in the form of an email or a letter.*
- Letter of support from Home University's research supervisor with his/her contact details**
- Detailed training [plan](#)**
- Curriculum vitae with publication list, if any**
