Dear Alumnus,

We refer to the recent announcement that NUS President Professor Tan Eng Chye will convene a review committee on sexual misconduct. The Board of Trustees views sexual misconduct on our campuses with grave concern, and has decided to appoint Mdm Kay Kuok, a member of the Board and Chairman of the Board's Nominating Committee, to chair this committee. The committee will review the disciplinary process (including sanctions) and support frameworks relating to sexual misconduct at NUS, in the light of concerns raised by Miss Monica Baey.

The initial members of the committee will comprise Singapore Management University President Professor Lily Kong, Board member and WongPartnership Managing Partner Mr Ng Wai King, Prof Tan, and a representative from the NUS Students' Union.

We note the strong public interest in this matter. The committee will proceed swiftly and decisively.
