ACADEMIC PLAN APPLICATION / DECLARATION - Declare Academic Plan Student User Guide



Overview

Academic Plan Declaration allows students to declare their Majors, Specialisations, Tracks, Minors and 2nd Majors during the main semesters.

Most Undergraduate programmes and a limited number of Graduate programmes require its students to declare their Academic Plan before the CourseReg exercise.

To ensure that students are assigned the appropriate curricular priority for their course choices in CourseReg, students are strongly advised to complete their Academic Plan Declaration (if applicable) <u>24 hours before</u> participating in the CourseReg exercise.

Academic Plan Declaration is required for the following Faculty/Schools:

Undergraduate

- Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences
- School of Business
- School of Computing
- College of Design and Engineering
- College of Humanities and Sciences
- Faculty of Law
- Faculty of Science
- Yong Siew Toh Conservatory of Music

Graduate

- School of Business (*applicable to selected programmes only)
- College of Design and Engineering (*applicable to selected programmes only)

Note:

Declarations can only be made during the designated declaration period for the semester. Students are <u>NOT allowed</u> to change their declaration within the same semester once it has been submitted.

If students have any questions or need clarification regarding their Academic Plan(s), they should contact the relevant Faculty, College, School, Department, or Institute.


^{*} Academic Plan Declaration requirement is determined by the student's home faculty. Thus, please check with your home faculty/department if you have queries with regards to the requirements.

Step by Step guide for 'Academic Plan Declaration – Declare Academic Plan'


1) Navigate to Academic Plan Declaration

Once you have logged in, you will see **My Homepage** with picture icons which you can select and navigate to the respective pages in EduRec.


Click Academics icon.



Click Acad Plan Appln/Declaration Icon.




Click on 'Declare Academic Plan'



3) Verify your current Academic Programme


a) For Students who are not allowed to read a new Major, you will see a page that shows your current Academic Programme.

Click 'Next' button, then go to Step 5.




b) For Students who are allowed to read a new Major, the Major Declaration page will show your current Academic Programme.


Click 'Next' button if you do not wish to read a new Major, then go to Step 5




- 4) Declare a New Major (For Students who are allowed to read a new Major)

Click the magnifying glass to change Major, Specialisation, Tracks, 2nd Major or Minor.



Priority Ranking for Specialisation


Undergraduate students are required to rank their specialisation for the purpose of calculating the Priority Score for a course he/she selects in Course Registration (CourseReg).

Only First Major First Specialisation will be given priority. First Major Second Specialisation onwards will be given First Major priority.



Click the Magniflying glass. (Do not just type the title in the textbox.)




Select the 2nd Major from the lookup table.




6) Complete your Declaration.

Slide to 'Yes' and Click Submit button if selection shown is correct.





Frequently Asked Questions

1) I forgot to opt for a new Second Major or Minor / I declared the wrong Second Major or Minor, what can I do? Can I make changes to my declaration? Can I re-declare my academic plans?

Students may not modify their declaration for the current semester after submission. You may wish to make the changes in the exercise for the next semester.

2) I cannot find the restricted Second Major or Minor which I want to declare, what shall I do?

Approval from the host faculty/department is required for enrolment into a restricted programme, and students are required to apply to the programme. The stipulated period for submitting applications for restricted programme is already over (April for Semester 1, November for Semester 2). You may want to submit your application in the next exercise. An email circular will be sent out to students nearer to the date of the next exercise.

3) It's beyond my 5th semester of study, can I still change or opt for a new Second Major or Minor?

You are not allowed to make changes or opt for a new Second Major or Minor beyond your 5th semester of study.

- 4) I have accepted a Transfer to another programme, but my academic plans are not updated yet, shall I proceed with Academic Plan Declaration?

 You may wish to proceed to submit the Academic Plan Declaration with the current academic plans. Your academic plans will be updated to your Student Records directly upon successful transfer of programme. If you need further assistance with your academic plans after the transfer, you can approach your new faculty or department.
- 5) I have just submitted my Academic Plan declaration; can you expedite the processing so that I can access to CourseReg?

Processing for Academic Plan Declaration is done via a scheduled system process; thus, we cannot accelerate the process. Students are reminded to submit their academic plan declaration at least 24 hours before participating in the CourseReg exercise.
