I am delighted to announce the next recipient of the 2023 Young Researcher Award – Professor Qu Hsueh Ming.

Hsueh Ming is a Provost’s Chair Professor of Philosophy at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, and an expert in the philosophy of David Hume. His book, *Hume’s Epistemological Evolution*, published in 2020 by Oxford University Press, has received excellent reviews and was nominated for the American Philosophical Association’s Book Prize in 2021. Hsueh Ming’s other key publications include the article “Complex Ideas and Hume’s Separability Principle”, published in the journal *Mind*, and “Hume’s Stoicism: Reflections on Happiness and the Value of Philosophy”, published in the *Journal of the History of Philosophy*.

He is also Associate Editor of the Australasian Journal of Philosophy, a member of the Hume Society Executive Committee, and Director of NUS Press.

As a result of his scholarship, Hsueh Ming was recently listed as one of the key figures in Early Modern Philosophy, alongside giants of other subfields such as John Rawls and David Lewis.
