Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Office of the University Registrar's website.  Please provide a valid, personal mailing address to the host university so that the host can send your transcript to you directly after the summer programme. If the host issues an electronic transcript, please provide your personal NUS email address to receive the transcript.
