

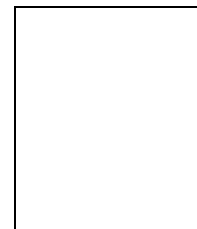
# TAN MINGWEI GLOBAL COMMUNITY SERVICE GRANT
