

### What is SEP?

SEP is an opportunity for students to:

- Spend **one or two semesters** studying at a partner university
- Earn **modular credits** toward their major in a new academic setting
- 3 Immerse themselves in a new place and culture
- Enjoy **tuition-fee waiver** from the partner institution, and pay NUS tuition fees for the exchange semester(s)

Maximise your term breaks by joining a short-term programme like a summer/winter academic programme, a research attachment at a partner university, a study trip or even a special exchange programme to China!



- shorter in duration than SEP; offers students the opportunity to explore non-traditional study abroad destinations
- cultivates a deeper appreciation of diverse cultures and lifestyles in different countries while not affecting the academic term.

### Study Trips for Engagement and EnRichment (STEER)

- Aims to familiarise students with the diverse socio-cultural-political-economic environments of newly emerging markets
- Offers opportunities for engagement with government agencies, educational and business institutions
- Thematic Programmes






### Semester at Sea (SAS)
