1	Programme Fee	All students selected to take part in the Research Program will receive financial support from École Polytechnique through the International Affairs Office (DRI) and/or through one of the institution's laboratories. A monthly stipend ranging from €550 to €750 will be provided to cover accommodation, meals, and personal expenses (the amount will be defined according to different factors, including the cost of living in the student's home country). This stipend includes health coverage. For some countries, the program may cover the roundtrip airfare in a flat amount. 		Nominated applicants will be required to: • Submit their application through the Online Application System. The link to the application is also available on the Research Program website • As part of the application process, applicants will be required to prepare the following documents • Approval by your home institution (nominated applicants will receive a signed copy of the form) • Detailed resume • Statement of Purpose: in French or in English (including research subjects you are interested in and why you are qualified for these subjects • Official transcripts of records, including full details of all university-level courses (scanned copies) • Contact details for two referring professors, who will be contacted automatically by the application platform. • Scanned copy of your passport The application deadline for nominated applicants to submit their applications is 19 January 2025.
8	Confirmation of participation	Accepted applicants will be informed by email at the beginning of March and finalise the details of their stay at I'X with our support (visa, fellowship, exact dates and duration of stay).
		To confirm your participation in this Programme, you must accept the EduRec-GE offer and the host university's offer.
9	Course Mapping	All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments. If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer. Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. Please read the information on the Office of the University Registrar's website for details.
