1	Programme Fee	USD 2500 – 3000, depending on project. Fee includes programme fee, accommodation and airport transfer.  Excludes airfare.			
2	Financial Aid Available Through NUS GRO	Financial Aid options will not be available for programmes/classes that are conducted fully online. If programmes are hybrid, only on-site participation would qualify a student for financial aid. If a physical/on-site programme switches to fully online before the commencement of the programme, NUS reserves the right to adjust or retract the financial aid package.  However, eligible students will receive the NUS India Experience Award (IEA) which can be applied through EduRec. More information about the IEA can be found on the GRO website.			

PR	PROGRAMME DETAILS			
3	Academic Content	The Ashoka International Summer Research Programme (AISRP) offers internships for undergraduate and master's students from international partner and non-partner universities to participate in cutting edge interdisciplinary research carried out by faculty and research centres at Ashoka. Students will work closely with faculty mentors and their research groups that include graduate and PhD students. Students will apply to the available research projects put out by Ashoka faculty/lab of their interest and technical skills.		
		The aim of this summer research internship is to expose participating students to a broad range of concepts and research techniques which will help to improve their scientific curiosity and advance their research capabilities. At the end of the summer research internships, students will have the opportunity to present their work to the larger scientific community, participating students and mentors at Ashoka.		

		Note: NUS students should not apply for projects that extends into NUS AY 24/25 semester 1. If students are interested in projects that have an end date of 24 August 2024, students should write in to the university to request for a shift in dates.

If you are interested in obtaining credits, you can start the course mapping process after you have accepted the offer for the programme via EduRec-GE.  Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each summer programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each winter programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.  Of the units approved for mapping, a total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition.
