### **IMPORTANT: COVID-19 related updates**

Due to the fluid situation of the COVID-19 pandemic, there is still much uncertainty regarding international travel in the months ahead.

Students' ability to travel to UK for summer 2022 will be determined by the host country's travel policies as well as the latest travel advice from Singapore authorities. Do factor in the need for quarantine in the host country and stay-home notice upon return to Singapore when considering the feasibility of participating in summer programmes.

To be eligible for physical (on-site) summer programmes, students will need to:

- 1. fully vaccinated
- 2. complete the compulsory Overseas Travel Preparedness (OTP) module on LumiNUS **one month before** the programme start date;
- 3. submit a copy of the completed Risk Acknowledgement and Consent Form on LumiNUS (folder within the OTP module);
- 4. register with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or your country's diplomatic mission; and
- 5. attend a pre-departure conducted by GRO.

Students who proceed with the physical (on-site) option acknowledge the risks associated. NUS will not be responsible for any lost deposits or expenses (including but not limited to programme/tuition fees, air tickets, housing deposits, meal plans and/or non-academic student fees) associated with travel disruptions.

You are advised NOT to make any financial commitments particularly those which are non-refundable until you are certain that travel is possible. You will be fully responsible for any travel expenses, quarantine accommodation costs, COVID-19 tests or other costs.
