6	Accommodation	Peking University Global Village  Accommodation is available only to students who have chosen the onsite course, and the length of the accommodation depends on the length of the on-site course chosen by the applicant, i.e. two weeks if the applicant has chosen a two-week on-site course; If the applicant chooses the four-week on-site course, the length of the stay is four weeks.  Students can apply for on-campus accommodation at the PKU Global Village (opposite PKU east gate) for the duration of the programme.		
		Please note that vacancy is limited and on first-apply first served basis.  Living on campus is not mandatory for PKUSSI students, and you can find your own off-campus accommodation.  Successful applicants will be assigned to the dormitories consisted of two or three bedrooms (one student occupies one room) with a shared		



		living room and shared bathroom. Air-conditioning, and cable Internet are available.
