7	Application Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students must apply in NUS Education Records System (EduRec) in order to proceed with course mapping, submission financial aids application. 2. Students should register with RUC at http://jw.ruc.edu.cn/Minjw/#/student-login. Once approved by RUC, students will need to pay for registration and tuition fee before selecting courses. Please refer to RUC application procedure at http://iss.ruc.edu.cn/admission_application.php 3. Accept both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.
8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping. Also note the following:</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Office of the University Registrar's website.</p>
