5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>The Summer Programme is designed for undergraduate students (that has completed at least one year of study) with any kind of academic background.</p> <p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply. Please refer to the GRO website for details.</p>
6	Accommodation	<p>Accommodation in Berlin can be found here.</p> <p>Should university-arranged accommodation not be available, you will be responsible for securing your accommodation.</p>
7	Application Procedure	<p>Please apply through the NUS Education Records System - Global Education (EduRec-GE) first if you want to do module mapping and apply for financial aid/loans. Applying through EduRec-GE will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while overseas.</p> <p>With an official application through EduRec-GE, you are covered by the NUS Travel Blanket Insurance. Besides, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application. Read the step-by-step guide we prepared for you on GRO's website.</p> <p>You should also concurrently apply to the host university once you have applied to NUS Edu-Rec.</p>
8	Application Procedure at Host University	<p>To apply for this programme, you need to submit an online application via Free University Berlin's website.</p>
9	Confirmation of participation	<p>To confirm your participation in this Programme, you must accept both the EduRec offer and the host university's offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p>
10	Course Mapping	<p>All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments.</p> <p>If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to</p>

		the host university. Please read the information on the Office of the University Registrar's website for details.
11	Transcript	<p>Please provide a valid, personal mailing address in the online registration portal so the host can send your transcript to you after the summer programme.</p> <p>Please do not request that your transcript be mailed to the NUS Global Relations Office (GRO). GRO is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>

12	Visa Application	<p>Holders of a Singapore passport do not require a visa for visits to Germany lasting up to 90 days. For other nationalities, please enquire with the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany in Singapore for visa requirements.</p> <p>If you need a visa to enter Germany, please start early, as your application may take up to two months.</p>
13	Travel Advisories	Visit the MFA website for travel advisories from the Singapore government in various countries.
14	Student Insurance	<p>NUS will continue to offer NUS Travel Insurance for approved study abroad programmes, including summer/winter programs (SWP).</p> <p>For more information on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - NUS Student Travel Insurance Cover, click here <p>Students are responsible for ensuring that they have sufficient travel insurance coverage for the entire duration of their trip (including travel) and are advised to review the insurance coverage/policy to ensure that it meets their needs.
