You must accept both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme. Once instructions have been received, kindly complete the application via the host university by 20 April 2024. ✓ Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and apply for financial aid.			
6	Course Mapping	You can start the course mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. For clarification, students may contact the SEP administrators/coordinators at their respective home Faculty/School Bearly Office or the academic department.			
		their respective home Faculty/School Dean's Office or the academic department before applying for the programme. Students may map up to a maximum of 10 Units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 Units for summer programmes. Beyond 12 Units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. For details, visit the Registrar's Office website. Course mapping requests are subjected to approval from the Faculties.			

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION				
7	Visa Application	Students from the U.S., Canada, and most European countries do not need a visa if they stay in Japan for less than 90 days. On the other hand, those who are from many Asian, African, and Middle Eastern countries will need visas to visit Japan. The Waseda Summer Session Office will send you a "Certificate of Admission" and invitation letter after confirming the payment. Applicants requiring a visa should apply at their local Japanese Embassy/Consulate General on their own. It may take several weeks to have a visa issued. Note: It is the student's responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangements for their summer programme. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for visa as early as possible as obtaining a visa can be time consuming.		
8	Student Insurance	NUS will continue to offer NUS Travel Insurance for approved study abroad programmes including International Summer Programmes (i-SP). Students are responsible for ensuring that they have sufficient travel insurance coverage. Exclusions to the NUS blanket travel insurance may apply. Students may consider purchasing additional travel insurance if required.
