With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request GRO for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>✓ Please read the application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	Module Mapping	<p>Students interested in obtaining credit can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Module mapping request is subjected to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping.</p> <p>Students may contact the SEP administrators/coordinators at their respective home Faculty/School Dean's Office or the academic department for module mapping. NUS Business School will not consider summer programme of less than 3 weeks duration to be credit bearing.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 MCs for involvement in summer programme. Beyond 12MCs, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	
Visa	<p>Students from countries or regions where Korea has signed a Visa waiver agreement may enter Korea without a visa for the summer programme.</p> <p>Singaporeans are not required to obtain a visa.</p> <p>Students from other countries not listed in the visa exemption list must apply for a short-term study visa (D-2-8) on their own. The list of countries with visa exemption is available at the Korean Embassy website.</p> <p>It is student's responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangement for their winter programme. Obtaining a visa may be time consuming. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for a visa as early as possible. The host university will send the documents required for your visa application to the address that you have indicated on your application for the summer programme after you have completed the payment for the programme. Kindly ensure that you have indicated your address correctly to avoid any delays.</p> <p>If you require GRO to issue a supporting letter for your visa application, you may download this form and follow the instructions listed within (after you have applied in EduRec and received confirmation of acceptance from the host university).</p>

Student Travel Insurance	<p>NUS will continue to offer NUS Travel Insurance for approved study abroad programmes including international Summer Programmes (i-SP). For more information on COVID-related coverage under the NUS Student Insurance Scheme, please refer to the following link: https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/</p> <p>Travellers to South Korea must purchase travel insurance with a minimum coverage of 30 million won (approximately SGD 34,000) for COVID-19 related medical/treatment expenses and hospitalisation cost. The traveller must carry a physical copy of the insurance policy when travelling to Korea. This specific requirement is provided for under the NUS Student Travel Insurance, which covers medical treatment and expenses (including for Covid-19) for up to SGD250,000.</p> <p>Students are responsible for ensuring that they have sufficient travel insurance coverage for the full duration of their trip (including travelling). Please review the insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs. Students may purchase additional health and/or travel insurance from their preferred agent.</p>
