As the COVID-19 pandemic remains an on-going situation globally, NUS has made the difficult decision to **extend the suspension of on-site / physical summer programmes into Summer 2021 (May to July 2021)**. NUS students are only allowed to take online courses; travel for overseas summer programmes 2021 is not allowed.

3	Academic Content	<p>Courses generally carry 3 credits. Students may take up to 3 courses.</p> <p>Visit https://summer.yonsei.ac.kr/home/program/course_main.asp for info.</p> <p>Internships:</p> <p>YISS participants have the option to take a 6-week internship program (online options available – please check with YISS if interested) during the full duration of the YISS program from 21 June to 5 August 2021. Students are required to work about 26 hours per week and take a YISS course concurrently. A total of 6 credit points (3 credits for internship and 3 credits for a YISS course) will be accorded upon completion of the Program. Kindly note that the YISS Internship course will be graded on Pass/Non-pass basis.</p> <p>(a) The Research Internship Program offers selected YISS students the opportunity to participate in research projects or work as an intern in research centers or organisations at Yonsei University. Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with module mapping and apply for financial aid. Please read the application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.
6	Module Mapping	<p>Students interested in obtaining credit can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme.
