Due to the COVID-10 situation, El Colegio de Mexico has announced that the summer programme will be offered 100% online for 2021.

Students may apply for module mapping and transfer a maximum of 8 MCs (this is applicable only to online summer programmes 2021). Some Faculties/Schools (including School of Computing) will not approve module mapping for online courses. Please check with your home faculty's Dean's Office to determine if module mapping can be approved for online courses before applying to the partner university.

**PROGRAMME DETAILS**

4	<b>Academic Content</b>	The International Summer Program is taught in English and its curriculum focuses on the study of Mexican and Latin American realities as approached by the faculty at ColMex. Students choose at least 2 courses (maximum 4) from the
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		<p>academic catalogue. Each course comprises 12 hours of class time.</p> <p>In addition to these courses, students on the program will be offered Spanish language classes at elementary (A1), basic (A2) and intermediate (B1) level.</p> <p>All enrolled in the Program will receive a certificate of attendance and a grade report confirming only passing scores (8 or above in a 10 point scale). 8	<b>Module Mapping</b>	<p>You can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. <a href="#">Click here</a> for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping. Also note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maximum of 2 modules (up to 10 MCs) can be mapped per summer / research programme during Special Term (May – August).</li> <li>• Maximum of 1 module (up to 5 MCs) can be mapped per winter / research programme during year-end vacation (December – January).</li> <li>• Total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition.
