This program will prepare the new leaders to undertake the new challenges in this era of globalization.</p> <p>Overall, participants will engage in a comprehensive program comprising lectures, interactive workshops, enriching field trips, and cross-cultural collaborative learning experiences.</p>

6	Course Mapping	<p>You can start the course mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme.</p> <p>For clarification, students may contact the SEP administrators/coordinators at their respective home Faculty/School Dean's Office or the academic department before applying for the programme.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 Units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 Units for summer programmes. Beyond 12 Units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. For details, visit the Registrar's Office website.</p> <p>Course mapping requests are subjected to approval from the faculties.</p>
