3	Content	This course immerses students in the settings, material culture, and living heritage that lend character to and enliven the city of Baguio. The student's investigation of the significance of these to the citizens will include a historical understanding of the city through place-based memory archiving and sensory ethnography.

Human stories intersect with the physical city in these 'small locations' that citizens experience tied together by a mode of mobility and relational networks that also inflect meaning.
