Due to the COVID-19 situation, King's has announced that they are offering the KCL Undergraduate Online Summer School which gives you the opportunity to experience the UK higher education system from anywhere in the world. King's will use online lectures, group seminars and guest speakers to make summer classes as engaging and informative as possible.

Students may apply for module mapping and transfer a maximum of eight (8) MCs (this is applicable only to electronic summer programmes 2021). Please note that some Schools or Faculties (including School of Computing) will not approve module mapping for remote or online courses. Please check with your home School or Faculty Dean's Office to determine if module mapping can be approved for remote/online courses before applying to the partner university.

3	Academic Content	<p>King's Undergraduate Online Summer School offers a wide range of modules spanning subject areas such as health and science, law, governance, business management, culture and ancient languages.</p> <p>For more information on modules: https://www.kcl.ac.uk/summer/university-level/online-summer-school</p> <p>King's Undergraduate Online Summer School modules comprise 150 study hours over three weeks, which includes 45 hours of online learning activities and live classes, as well as independent study, team project work and assessment preparation.</p> <p>All students will receive a final mark on their Record of Agreed Results (transcripts), which facilitates credit transfer if needed.</p> <p>The Summer Society Attending the Online Undergraduate Summer School automatically enrolls you into King's Summer Society. Get involved in a variety of online social activities including a traditional British pub quiz, take advantage of live streams from London's key cultural institutions and interact with current King's undergraduates throughout the summer. The series of wider skills sessions are designed to help you build for success, network internationally and get the most out of your summer online experience at King's.</p>

If you have not previously applied to King's, you will need to register an account in order to make an application.</p> <p>Select 'NO' in response to 'Are you applying via a King's Approved Agent, King's Partner or Study Abroad coordinator?' and SAVE.</p> <p>As NUS is King's partner university, you do not require a partner code to enjoy the benefits offered by King's, however please remember to fill in "National University of Singapore" as the home institution in your application to KCL Summer Programme. All NUS students enjoy application fee waiver of £60 and discounted tuition fee.</p> <p>The application process will take approximately 7 working days. 6	Application Procedure at NUS	<p>You are REQUIRED TO apply via NUS' EduRec-GE AND the host university's website <u>concurrently</u>.</p> <p>Please apply through NUS EduRec System if you want to do module mapping and apply for financial aid. Applying through EduRec will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen). Read the step-by-step guide which we have prepared for you on GRO's web.</p> <p>Please note that you must accept <u>both</u> the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer in order to confirm your participation in this programme.</p>
