3	<b>Academic Content</b>	The essence of the Online Tutorials is the one-to-one, discussion-based learning that is central to student life in Oxford.  Exeter College offers three different types of tutorial: (1) the Oxford Tutorial, (2) the Tailored Oxford Tutorial and (3) the Independent Research Tutorial. 5	<b>Application Procedure at Host Institution</b>	<p>Competition for places to study on this programme will be intense and pairing you with a tutor requires time, so <b>early application is strongly recommended</b>.</p> <p>To be considered for admission, you will need to complete (1) an <a href="#">Online Summer Tutorial Proposal Form</a>, (2) provide the supporting documents listed on the '<a href="#">Entry Requirements</a>' section and (3) pay a £60 administration fee. 6	<b>Application Procedure at NUS</b>	<p><b>Please apply through Host Institution.</b></p> <p>Applications are to be submitted directly to Exeter College and application on EduRec is not required.</p>
7	<b>Module Mapping</b>	<p>Online summer programmes taken while physically in Singapore, whilst credit-bearing by the partner universities, are offered to NUS students for enrichment only. Module mapping and financial assistance are not applicable to any online summer programmes taken while physically in Singapore.</p>
8	<b>Transcript</b>	<p><u>The Oxford Tutorial and the Tailored Oxford Tutorial</u> You will be assessed on the pieces of work you produce for each tutorial. Your tutor will give you a grade (and feedback) for each piece of work with your final grade being an accumulated average of all marks.</p> <p><u>The Independent Research Tutorial</u> You will be assessed on your final research essay or paper.</p> <p>Please read <a href="#">here</a> for more information. Students who successfully complete the tutorial will receive a transcript showing a grade expressed as a grade-% and a letter equivalent, together with grading guidance notes.</p> <p>Please note that module mapping is not applicable to any online summer programmes taken while physically in Singapore.</p>
